

Rubric for Scoring Math Problems

Score Point 3

- My answer is correct.
- You can tell **I understood** what I was doing and how to go about solving the problem.
- You can **see what I was thinking** by my equations, graphs, tables, charts or pictures.
- I **explained** what I did very **clearly** by using **words AND numbers**.

Score 2

- My answer **may or may not be correct**, but I **showed I understood most** of the problem and how to solve it.
- I **showed** my **thinking** with equations, graphs, tables, charts, or pictures.
- My **explanation** was **understandable**. I explained what I did using **words AND numbers**.

Score 1

- I have the **correct answer** but I **left out parts** of my explanation and/or **my words were not clear**.

OR

- I had the **wrong answer** but I **showed I understood some** of the problem.

Score 0

- I **didn't have the right answer** and I **couldn't explain** what I was thinking very clearly.
- I only **understood a little** of the problem and how to solve it.
- I **couldn't organize** my thoughts and/or I **didn't finish** solving the problem or showing my work.
