IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM THE P.E. DEPARTMENT

This week, our 3rd and 4th grade students will begin the Fitness Unit in preparation for the Connecticut State Fitness Assessment. Part of this mandated assessment is the Mile Run. We typically start off the unit with having our students run 2 laps around the RES Field and gradually increase their cardiovascular endurance by working up to 5 laps (1 mile).

Due to the heavy rains/floods that have saturated the grounds these past weeks, the field has been extremely wet in the mornings. Since many of our 3rd and 4th grade students have PE at 8:35 in the morning, wet sneakers and socks will be inevitable. We recommend that students bring an extra pair of socks to school with them and, if possible, another pair of shoes to change into after PE class. This will be for the month of September and the first two weeks of October support when this unit will be completed and students will have finished the Mile Run assessment.

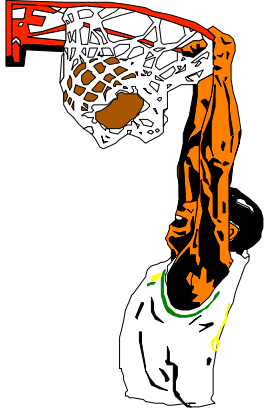
